Welcome to the first newsletter of the school year. These will usually appear in your inbox every other week. Hopefully, they will be a useful place to go to find out more about what is going on in school, for regular updates and also for information from other members of the local community.

Information Meetings - throughout this week and next, our teachers have been holding Year group meetings for parents and carers to come and hear about what the children will be learning throughout the year, with a particular focus on this term and how you can help and support their learning. Do look out for copies of these information sheets in your emails. They are a handy reference point for things like topics, homework, PE days, dates and staff email addresses.

School Photographs – our photographer, Andy Faulkner, visited us this morning and took photos of individual children and, where possible, with their siblings. How smart everyone looked! You will be provided with a code which you can use to view and order images of your child online.

Year 6 France visit – in ten days' time (Monday 21st September), most of our Year 6 children and five lucky staff (including me) will be enjoying a residential visit to the Picardie region of France – famous for the World War One battlefields of the Somme and just a coach drive from Paris where we will be spending the day on Tuesday. Bon voyage!

Progress Evenings – the first proper chance to hear about how children are doing comes in mid October with our two progress evenings. More details will follow but the dates are Wednesday 14th and Thursday 15th October. In the meantime, if you do have a concern, please feel free to approach teachers at the end of the day, email them or make contact via the school office. A small concern can usually be dealt with before it becomes a bigger worry.

Medication – all medications must be clearly labelled with the child's name and dose and brought into the school office/collected by an adult. If you know that you have provided medication for your child before, it is worth checking that inhalers for example and any other medicines are still within their use by dates.

Pupil Premium - all schools are offered a small grant for each child that qualifies as Pupil Premium. This includes: any child who has received free school meals in the past 6 years; children in care, or previously in care; children with parents in the armed forces; and children of families who qualify for Universal Credit, Child Tax Credit and Working Tax Credit. As a school we use this funding to support parents with the costs of residential trips, uniforms, holiday clubs and other areas of learning and pastoral support in the school day. On our website is a detailed report breaking down how the school uses the funding each year. If you think your child may qualify for Pupil Premium funding then please contact the school office. It would really help with funding these important areas of school life.

Parking – is never easy being in a school at the end of a cul-de-sac. Children and cars really do not mix well so please do avoid coming into the school car park which is for staff use only. Children should not cross the car park but use the safe pathway around the edge to the playground or main entrance. We do have a disabled space and this is for blue badge holders only – please display your badge should you need to use the space.

Please do park respectfully – not blocking pavements, driveways or in the private garage area.

House Captains – our Year 6 children will be preparing to put themselves forward in our annual House Captain election next week. A boy and girl from each house are elected by the other children in the house from across the school. The runners up become Vice Captains. Good luck to everyone who puts themselves forward. The results will be announced towards the end of the week.

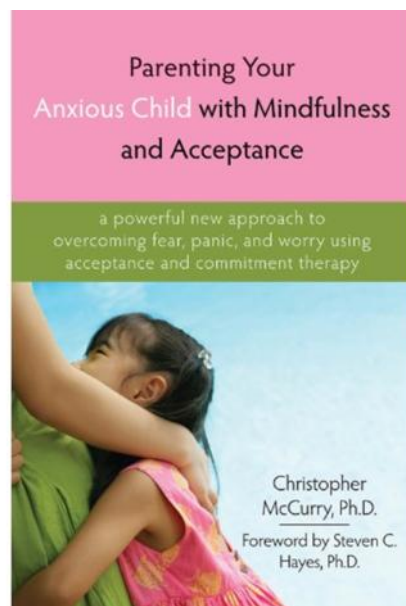

FOOTBALL SQUAD

This year, we're excited to be putting together a football squad for each year group to represent Chandler in future matches and tournaments.

If your child would like the opportunity to be part of their year group squad, we'd love them to come along to one of our **football training sessions**. These sessions will happen during lunch time and will give us a chance to see the children play together and help us decide who we feel is currently the best fit.

When choosing our squads, we won't just be looking at footballing ability. We'll also be considering effort, teamwork, attitude, sportsmanship, behaviour around the school, and how well children represent our school and its values. We understand that, unfortunately, we won't be able to include everyone in the squad this time around. SECONDARY SCHOOL APPLICATIONS

Applications can now be made online at www.surreycc.gov.uk/admissions. The closing date for applications is **31st October 2026** but we suggest that you ensure your application is submitted by **Friday 16th October 2026** which is the last day of school before half term.

ABSENCE REMINDER

Just to remind parents/carers that if they take their children out of school without authority for 5 or more days (which do not have to be consecutive), then the following will apply:

1. If you have not incurred a penalty notice relating to this child/children in a rolling 3 year period since 19 August 2024, then the penalty notice will be charged at the rate of £160.00, **per parent/carer per child**, if paid within 28 days. This will be reduced to £80.00 if paid within 21 days of receipt of the notice. Failure to pay the Penalty Notice will result in Surrey County Council considering legal proceedings against you in the Magistrates Court.
2. If you have incurred a penalty notice relating to this child/children since 19 August 2024, the rolling 3 year period will be activated from the date of the first penalty notice and the second penalty notice will be charged at the flat rate of £160.00, **per parent/carer per child**, if paid within 28 days. There will be no reduction for payment within 21 days. Failure to pay the Penalty Notice will result in Surrey County Council considering legal proceedings against you in the Magistrates Court.
3. If you have incurred 2 penalty notices relating to this child/children in the rolling 3 year period since the first penalty notice was issued, then you will NOT receive a third penalty notice – Surrey County Council will have no option but to consider a prosecution, **per parent/carer per child**, in the Magistrates Court under s 444 Education Act 1996.

Surrey County Council is not responsible for authorising pupil absence and therefore cannot withdraw any Penalty Notice requests without the written permission of the Headteacher.

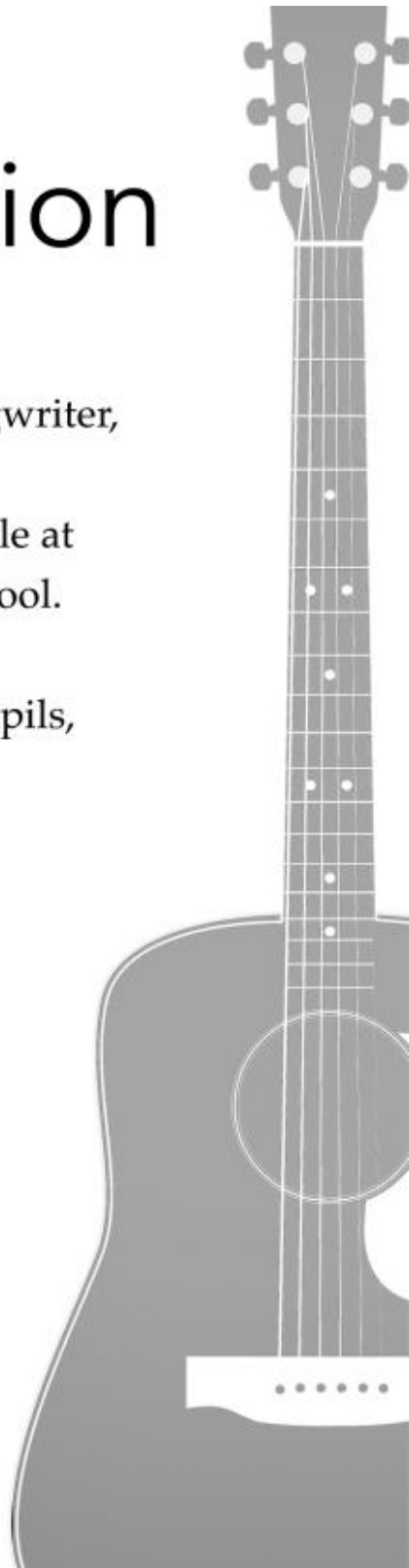

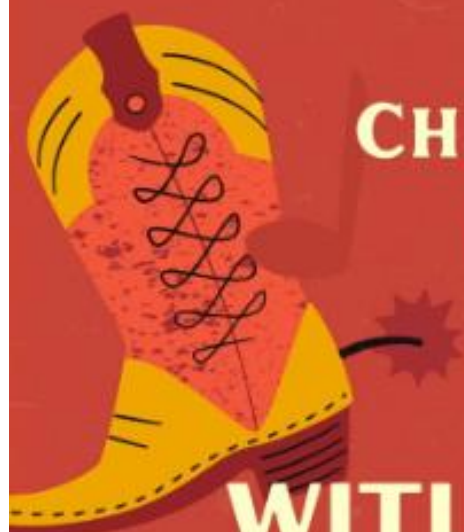
